Position Background (*Information on Project 22*)

Project 22 is a Football NSW initiative aimed at laying down the foundations required to give elite youth footballers the highest chance possible to succeed at the elite level as adult footballers. Project 22 aims to develop the next generation of Socceroos and Matildas who will compete at the FIFA World Cup in 2022. Project 22 is centered on FNSW being able to exceed world best practice in providing an elite competition and training environment for our future National Team Players.

There will be 6 regional programs for boys which include:

- Sydney West (Blacktown, Granville, Nepean)
- Sydney East (Canterbury, Eastern Suburbs, St George)
- Sydney South (Bankstown, Macarthur, Southern Districts)
- Sydney North (Gladesville-Hornsby, Manly-Warringah)
- Sydney Far North (Central Coast, Ku-ring-gai)
- Sydney Far South (Illawarra, Sutherland)

The age categories for the BOYS include the following composite age groups for 2009 / 2010;

- U10 (Born 2000 & 2001) x 14 players
- U12 (Born 1998 & 1999) x 14 players
- U14 (Born 1996 & 1997) x 14 players

There is one central region for GIRLS that will consist of 14 players in each age group
For 2009 / 2010;

U13 (Born 1997) x 14 players - U14 (Born 1996) x 14 players - U15 (Born 1995) x 14 players

Knowledge, skills and behavior required (*Essential competencies*)

1. Have a full understanding of Football Australia's National Football Curriculum and the confidence to deliver it to talented youth footballers
2. Have a minimum of 3 years experience coaching elite youth footballers
3. Hold a current Football Australia Coaching Licence – Minimum Senior Licence
4. Proven experience educating elite youth footballers

Key Outcomes (*Essential outcomes required*)

1. In conjunction with Football NSW actively promote Project 22 in the community and selected region.
2. Be in attendance at each Project 22 trial conducted by Football NSW.
3. Attend each Project 22 training session and game day.
4. Conduct monthly coaching updates in your Project 22 region for local coaches & associations.
5. Assist FNSW Talent Search Program / school holiday soccer clinics/camps in your region
6. Actively scouting potential Project 22 players in competitions and State Titles in your region
7. File monthly reports to the High Performance Manager on the progress of squad and attendance to training and games (template provided by FNSW)
8. Attend endorsed Coach Education Updates recommended by FNSW & FFA
9. Assist with coaching of State Teams if requested by FNSW;
10. Adherence at all times to Football NSW Policies and Procedure.
